## 1 GENERAL

### 1.1 SCOPE

This specification details the ratings, physical and electrical characteristics, and test and inspection data for the component type variants and/or the range of components specified below. It supplements the requirements of, and shall be read in conjunction with, the ESCC Generic Specification listed under Applicable Documents.

### 1.2 APPLICABLE DOCUMENTS

The following documents form part of this specification and shall be read in conjunction with it:

- (a) ESCC Generic Specification No. [3009](#).

### 1.3 TERMS, DEFINITIONS, ABBREVIATIONS, SYMBOLS AND UNITS

For the purpose of this specification, the terms, definitions, abbreviations, symbols and units specified in ESCC Basic Specification No. [21300](#) shall apply.

### 1.4 THE ESCC COMPONENT NUMBER AND COMPONENT TYPE VARIANTS

#### 1.4.1 The ESCC Component Number

The ESCC Component Number shall be constituted as follows:

- Detail Specification Reference: 3009040
- Component Type Variant Number: 01 (as required)
- Characteristic code: Capacitance Value (100pF): 1000 (as required)
- Characteristic code: Capacitance Tolerance ( $\pm 10\%$ ): K (as required)
- Rating code: Rated Voltage (50V): C (as required)

The maximum ratings shall not be exceeded at any time during use or storage.

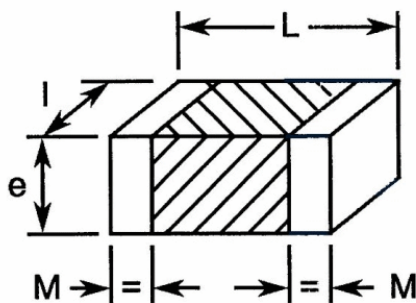
Maximum ratings shall only be exceeded during testing to the extent specified in this specification and when stipulated in Test Methods and Procedures of the ESCC Generic Specification.

## 2 REQUIREMENTS

### 2.1 GENERAL

The complete requirements for procurement of the components specified herein are as stated in this specification and the ESCC Generic Specification. Permitted deviations from the Generic Specification, applicable to this specification only, are listed below.

Permitted deviations from the Generic Specification and this Detail Specification, formally agreed with specific Manufacturers on the basis that the alternative requirements are equivalent to the ESCC requirement and do not affect the component's reliability, are listed in the appendices attached to this specification.

#### 2.1.1 Deviations from the Generic Specification

##### 2.1.1.1 *Deviations from Qualification and Periodic Tests (Chart F4)*

- (a) Solderability: not applicable to Variants 07 to 12 and 14.

### 2.2 MARKING

The marking shall be in accordance with the requirements of ESCC Basic Specification No. [21700](#) and as follows.

The information to be marked on the component or its primary package shall be:

- (a) The ESCC qualified components symbol (for ESCC qualified components only).
- (b) The ESCC Component Number.
- (c) Traceability information.

## 2.3 ELECTRICAL MEASUREMENTS AT ROOM, HIGH AND LOW TEMPERATURES

Electrical measurements shall be performed at room, high and low temperatures.

### 2.3.1 Room Temperature Electrical Measurements

The measurements shall be performed at  $T_{amb} = +22 \pm 3^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

- In the case of a 100% inspection, a 1% total percent defective is allowed.
- Temperature Coefficient is not specified for  $C_n \leq 20\text{pF}$  due to test equipment limitations.

## 2.4 INTERMEDIATE AND END-POINT ELECTRICAL MEASUREMENTS

Unless otherwise specified, the measurements shall be performed at  $T_{amb} = +22 \pm 3^{\circ}\text{C}$ .

Unless otherwise specified the test methods and test conditions shall be as per the corresponding test defined in Room Temperature Electrical Measurements.

### BURN-IN

The requirements for Burn-in are specified in the ESCC Generic Specification. The following conditions shall also apply:

- After Burn-in, the components shall be removed from the chamber and allowed to cool under normal atmospheric conditions for recovery for 24 hours minimum.
